Bent Creek Country Club – Golf Rules & Regulations

Bent Creek Dress Code

- 1. All members and their guests must be dressed in golf attire appropriate for ladies and gentlemen while on Club premises. The golf professional staff is authorized to indicate to members when their attire is inappropriate. Appropriate attire includes: shirts being tucked in, shoes laced, and hats being worn correctly with bill facing forward.
- 2. Men are required to observe good taste and dress appropriately while on the golf course or practice facility. Appropriate attire includes shirts with collars and neat pants or Bermuda length shorts. Fashion mock-turtlenecks or turtleneck shirts are permitted. Items of clothing such as blue denim jeans, short-shorts (bottom of shorts may be no higher than three inches from the top of the knee), gym shorts, cargo type pants, athletic/sweat pants, warm-up suits, tee shirts, and tank tops are considered inappropriate. Anyone attired in such a manner will not be permitted on the golf course.
- 3. Ladies are required to observe good taste and dress appropriately while on the golf course or practice facility. Fashion mock-turtleneck or turtleneck shirts are permitted. Fashion collarless shirts with sleeves or sleeveless shirts with collars are permitted. Blue denim jeans, tank tops, gym shorts, athletic/sweat pants, and tee shirts are considered inappropriate. Shorts may be no higher than three inches from the top of the knee. Anyone inappropriately attired will not be permitted on the golf course.
- 4. Sneakers, golf teaching shoes, or golf shoes with non-penetrating spikes are required on the golf course at all times. Practice facilities are considered part of the golf course.

Golf Carts

- 1. Please observe and adhere to the operational procedures posted on all carts.
- 2. For the protection of the course, please keep all carts outside of the blue stakes surrounding greens and avoid areas close to teeing grounds.
- 3. Please use cart paths where provided.
- 4. No more than two riders are permitted in a cart.
- 5. No more than two golf bags per cart.
- 6. You must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license to drive a golf cart.
- 7. Please report any equipment problems to the Pro Shop.
- 8. Individuals and host are responsible for any damage caused by golf carts.

Cell Phone Policy

1. On the golf course cell phones should only be used to report emergencies, equipment problems, and course damage.

2. When dining at the club cell phones must be placed on silent, vibrate, or turned off. If it is necessary to take the call, you should excuse yourself from the dining rooms and take the call in another area that does not interrupt those who are dining.

Home Owners – Property

- Damaged/Broken Windows All golfers are responsible for damage to homeowners windows. Golfers must report the incident to either the homeowner or golf professional. If the golfer does not report the incident, the responsibility will then be with the golf outing group.
- 2. Residential Yards Please refrain from entering private property/yards while playing at Bent Creek Country Club.

Country Club Behavior

- 1. The Bent Creek Golf Course is part of a residential neighborhood, appropriate behavior and language is expected at all times as courtesy to country club members and neighbors.
- 2. Smoking is prohibited everywhere, except on the golf course. Please dispose of all smoking litter in provided trash cans at each hole.
